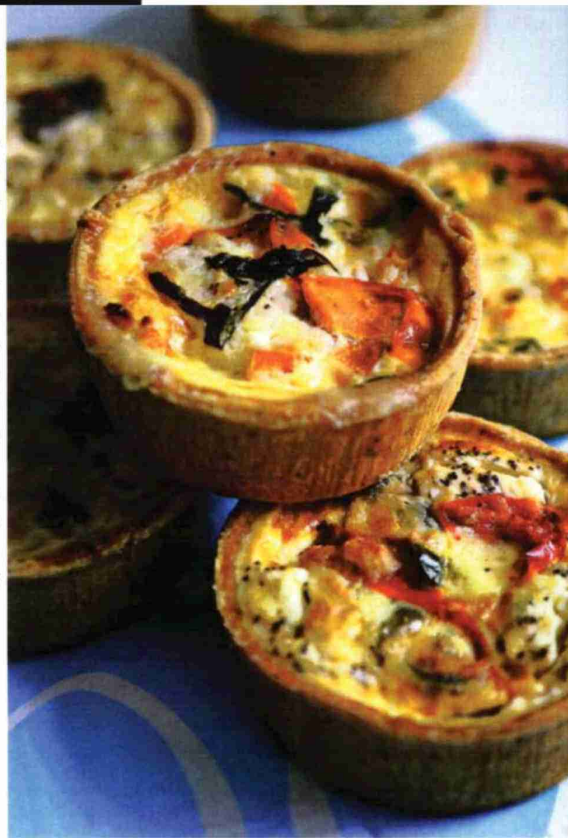
SABRINA VS HUNGER
